Overview

- This Code of Conduct outlines the standards of behaviours and ethical conduct expected for officials of Kalamunda City Football Club.
 - All officials are responsible for adhering to this code of conduct and are advised to familiarise themselves with the standards.
 - In general, it is expected that club officials represent the club in an appropriate manner which does not bring the club or football into disrepute.

Standards

- Respect the rights and dignity of every person regardless of gender, race, ethnicity or sexual orientation.
- Promote a safe and inclusive environment, in which every person is protected and free from discrimination, harassment and abuse.
- Always ensure the safety and wellbeing of players above all else.
- Maintain respectful and appropriate relationships with every person, especially to the players.
- Be impartial, consistent and transparent in your conduct and decision-making.
- Accept responsibility for your actions.
- Avoid situations that may lead to or call into question conflict of interest.
- At all times act as a role model for others, displaying high standards of good sporting behavior.

- Never engage in inappropriate conduct including the use of offensive language whilst in an official capacity.
- Adhere to the laws of the game and the principles of fair play, ensuring that the spirit of competition is respected by all players, coaches and officials.

Misconduct

- Any official who engages in misconduct may be sanctioned in accordance with the Club's Member Protection Policy and the decision of our Committee in following the policy.
- In the event the misconduct requires our state associations involvement, officials can be sanctioned in accordance with the relevant policies of the association.

Conclusion

All state and federal association Code of Conduct policies are applicable to officials, and go into greater depth on each area Standard of behaviour and ethical conduct. In the event, the above Standards are breached, it is recommended that the state and federal association Code of Conduct policies are referred to.
